2. **Breeder Futurity open to 3 years old horses in 2023** Open to all breeds —. See the current *NRHA Handbook* for information on how the age of a horse is determined. *The horses are to be shown one handed.* **The IRHA Futurity is open only to those offspring by stallions that are subscribed in the IRHBA incentive program for the breeding season 2019 or foals enrolled separately (2023 foals).** On www.irhba.com you can have the complete list
3. **PARTICIPATION:**
Entries will not be considered unless forms are completely filled in and received by the organizer in due time, accompanied by horse documentation (AQHA, APHA, etc.) including NRHA Competition License, a copy of the valid NRHA Membership Card (rider and owner), and evidence of payment of all fees. Permission to participate will not be granted unless a valid NRHA Membership Card is provided latest on the day of the event, regardless if a NRHA Membership Card exists and is valid at the time of the event.
Rider/horse owner assures that the horse(s) is free of any contagious diseases, properly vaccinated according to Italian regulations and laws and carries public liability insurance at the time the horse arrives at the show grounds. Rider/horse owner is aware of that they are personally liable of any damages caused by the horse if there is no liability insurance. The horse owner shall indemnify and hold harmless show organizer against any claims or legal proceedings brought by third parties.
The rider commits himself to pay the entry and stable fees, even in the event of his withdrawal with just cause.
The horse's ID paper (horse passport) and an additional health certificate for foreign competitors must be presented at the show office.
4. **NRHA COMPETITION LICENSE:** All horses competing in NRHA approved competitions will be **required** to have an NRHA competition license upon entering the NRHA European Futurity. A completed NRHA competition license application, copy of breed registration papers (or pictures for grade horses), and license fee must accompany the entry form if not previously applied for. Entries will not be accepted and will be returned if received without a license application for horses not already licensed and applicable late fees will be assessed. A photocopy of the breed registration papers must accompany application for registered horses. For non-registered horses, photographs showing full left and right sides and full front and back views, specifically showing all marks of identification, must be submitted with the application. Owners are required to be members of NRHA prior to completing the license process. If current year membership has not been paid, complete a membership application and return it with the competition license application. (Refer to the membership requirements in the current *NRHA Handbook* or at www.nrha.com.)



5. Owners and riders must be members of the NRHA. All riders must have individual memberships. (Refer to the membership requirements in the current NRHA Handbook.) Owners may enter more than one horse. Riders may ride no more than three horses per futurity class. All the Italian riders needs to have an Italian membership and a FISE licence from our Federation
6. All added monies will be expressed in EURO's until January 1 2023 and then calculated to US dollars (1,07).All other fees will be expressed in Euros with the conversion rate to be established on January 1.
7. The show retainage for the NRHA – IRHA Futurity will be 50% in addition to the standard 5% show fee deduction.
8. **PAYMENT OF FEES:** Complete payment information will be included on the entry form. It is the owner's responsibility to make the entry on or before the due date. Show Management will not be responsible for entries not received by the due date or lost in the mail. An entry check returned due to insufficient funds will constitute an incomplete entry. Failure to pay applies to the rider, owner, or agent for any unpaid debts, related to the entry, exhibition, showing, stalling, or any related fee of an entry at an approved NRHA event. Agent is defined as anyone who acts and/or signs on the behalf of an owner or rider (see General Rules and Regulations, F. Failure to pay in the current *NRHA Handbook*).
We will have 40% discount on the entry fee (without judge fee) for only one son of each stallion enrolled on the IRHBA program with a maximum of € 500,00.
9. **REFUNDS:** When the official draw is posted NO REFUND will be allowed
10. **CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP:** An entered horse may change ownership and retain entry status under the new owner **provided that the transfer of the NRHA Competition License is complete and the new owner is a member of the National Reining Horse Association.** Changes may not be made during the go-round
11. **SUBSTITUTION/TRANSFER OF ENTRY:** Substitutions of horses/entries will be permitted until the day before the show but if the unofficial draw is already posted the rider (if the division is changed) will be placed at the beginning of the draw
12. **SCRATCHES:** Show management must be notified if an entry will be scratched If the scratched entry has a balance due, (48 hrs before the competition). that amount must still be paid.
13. **JUDGE'S FEE:** The Judges fee is due at the time entry is made.
14. **JUDGES:** There will be five judges placed at different points in the arena: the high score and the low score will be eliminated with only the total of the remaining three scores used to determine the final score. These judges will be selected from the approved NRHA Judges list. A pre check will be utilized.
2 Point Penalty Review: During the NRHA Open and Non Pro FUTURITY, the judges will be allowed to review 2 point penalties for break of gait, jogging more than 2 strides and freeze ups as long as more than 1 judge has called the penalty 2.
15. **PAYEE:** Prize money will be paid to the owner as recorded in the NRHA database at the start of the event or designated agent. The prize money will be paid by bank transfer to the bank account of the Recipient of Invoice as filled in the entry form. Recipient of Invoice is responsible to provide the correct information for bank transfer. Show organizer is entitled to deduct any outstanding receivables related in any way to the entry form from the prize money. For foreign recipient of prize money (place of residence is not Italy) this applies also to the withholding according to the Italian tax law. If the data for payment are not indicated on the registration form, reference will be made to the data already present on our computer system.
16. **RIDER DESIGNATION:** Riders for horses entered in the Open/Non Pro Futurity must be designated no later than 9 October 2023
If the rider is not designated until the due date , IRHA is not responsible for draw positions closer than the conditions specify. For the Futurity go rounds, the Open draw will separate horses with a common rider by at least 15 horses or highest number possible. The Non Pro draw will separate horses with a common rider or owner by at least 15 horses or highest number possible.
It is mandatory to check the starting orders before the start of the categories. It will not be possible to add any level (either higher or lower than your status) after the start of the show **even if the registration was successful.** The official order will be posted the day before the show after 7.00 pm. Any changes can only be accepted within 30 minutes of the start of the categories of the day.



17. **TIES:** In the event of a tie in a final, the tie-breaking procedures as outlined in the current year *NRHA Handbook* will be used to break the tie.
18. **RIGHT TO CANCEL:** Entries are received subject to the right of the IRHA Executive Committee to refuse the entry, or a transfer of the entry, without notice to the subscriber. Acceptance of the entry is based on the representations made on the entry form. Decisions of the Executive Committee will be final. Riders are responsible to know and adhere to eligibility requirements for NRHA events. A rider who enters an event or division in which he/she is ineligible, will forfeit all winnings and entry fees to the NRHA, and be subjected to disciplinary action by the NRHA Board of Directors for unsportsmanlike conduct as set forth in the current *NRHA Handbook*. The rider is responsible for the entry information regardless of whether the form is completed by the agent or owner. **The Show Management reserves the right to cancel this event without notice at any time prior to the contest without liability, but in such event will return all entry money to the payee. Interest earned on all fees is the property of Show Management.**
19. NRHA rules will apply unless specifically deleted or altered. These rules and conditions are subject to change by action of the IRHA Board of Directors.
20. **DISCIPLINARY ACTION:** Each owner/rider assumes the obligation to ensure that the horse is approached only by known people (family members, vet, farrier, etc.). The Organizer reserves the right to sanction any unorthodox behavior carried out by individuals who have ties to the entered horse: for example for abuse against the horse. The organizer reserves the right, also through its collaborators (stewards), to sanction owners and riders for unsportsmanlike conduct, and/or for behavior contrary to ethics and civil behaviour. In this sense, official warnings may be issued, the suspension of the horse and/or rider from the competition may be ordered and, in extreme instance, forced removal from the competition venue may be ordered. No reimbursement in favor of the owner/rider will be due in application of the sanctions set out above.
In any case, the Organizer reserves the right to undertake the conduct it deems most appropriate in the interest of the best outcome of the event, the well-being and safety of people, animals and things.
21. **Conditions Changes:** The IRHA Board of Directors reserves the right to interpret, modify or amend conditions for the NRHA/IRHA Futurity and time table for a better result on the organization of the show.
22. **Switching from the Open Futurity to the Non Pro Futurity (or viceversa).** Any entry may switch from the Open Futurity to the Non Pro Futurity (or viceversa). That entry will then be placed in a group to precede the regular draw in the reverse order that they were received. The difference in entry fee will be refunded. New entries will be placed at the top of the draw if the draw is posted.
23. The Restricted NRHA European Eligibility will apply for all Category 6 Futurity classes.
24. **Animal Welfare and Medications Testing**
All horses entered in the NRHA/IRHA Futurity are subject to examination. Please refer to the NRHA European Region Animal Welfare and Medications policy for details on the Animal Welfare and Medications Rule.
It is not NRHA's intention to conflict with rules and regulations of states, provinces or countries in regards to medications. In cases, where NRHA shows are held in states, provinces or countries with medications rules and regulations, the rules and regulations of the state, province or country take precedence. - No schooling in the Consolation Class is permitted.

26. **Payout**

Payout Open Level 1, 2, 3 & 4 Non Pro Level 1, 2, 3 & 4

- The entire payout purse will be used for the finals.
- Every finalist will get a guaranteed base payout for the Level he/she made it back in plus a percentage from the left over purse for that Level

For all Futurity finalists the order of entry for the final will be inverse to the placement achieved in the go round (the best score will start last) respecting however and where possible a minimum distance of 8 horses for the riders who access the final with more of a horse (as per NRHA regulation).

For each award the withholding tax will be applied (20%)

The percentages will be calculated using the remaining entry fees, plus the added purse, and guaranteed base payout have been deducted. At no time will the purse payout exceed 100%

Payout schedules based on number of finalists will follow the NRHA schedule, if the finalists will be more then 15 please look at the attached schedule.

The entry fees will be divided as shown in the table above (4) less the 50% show retainage fee and the standard 5% show fee deduction, will be added back to the finals. The Level 4 Open division will consist of two go round composite score and a final. For the number of riders qualifying to the final please look at the point 25. The winner will be determined by the finals score. € 3.000 for each go round will be paid out following this schedule 34% - 27% - 20% - 10% - 9%.
7. **LEVEL 4 OPEN DIVISION FINALIST AND PAYOUTS:** The number of finalist advancing to the finals and finals payouts will be determined by the schedule outlined in event conditions.
8. **LEVEL 3 OPEN DIVISION:** The Level 3 Open Division purse will have € 45.220,00 added plus the entry fee allocation. 12. **LEVEL 1 OPEN DIVISION:** The Level 1 Open Division purse will have € 11.900,00 added plus the entry fee allocation.
